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# 1. Pre-Installation Check

## 1.1 Documentation Overview

## 1.2 Installation and Placement

Installation and placement of this machine must be performed by trained and qualified personnel.

### WARNING

Transportation, unloading, and installation must be carried out by trained and qualified personnel only. Proper handling requires appropriate equipment and technical expertise. ## 1.3 Installation Location Precautions

Install the machine in a stable, vibration-free environment suitable for reliable operation.

Installing the machine in an unsuitable location may result in accidents, fire hazards, operational malfunction, or equipment damage.

### WARNING

Install the machine on a level, stable surface capable of supporting its full weight. The total weight of the machine may reach 170 kg or more. Failure to install the machine on an appropriate surface may result in serious accidents, including tipping, falling, or structural collapse.

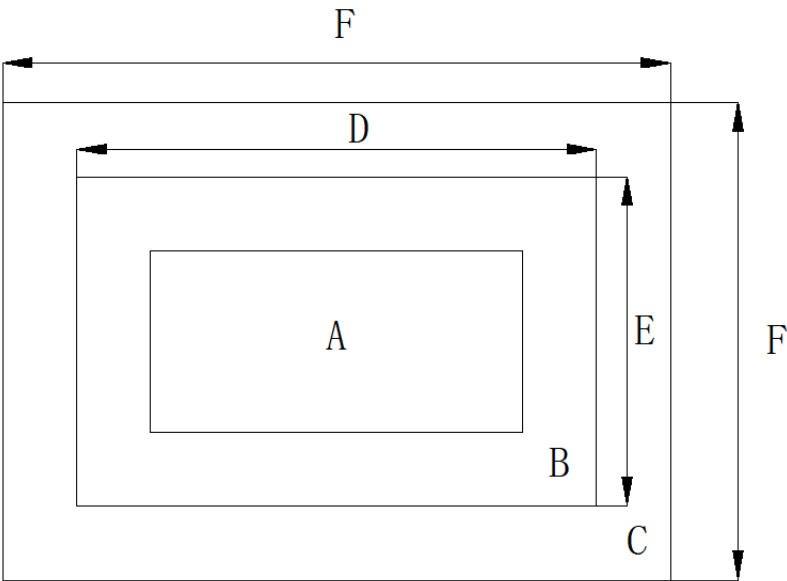

**1.4 Temperature and Humidity**

Maintain the specified temperature and humidity conditions at all times, even when the machine is not in operation.

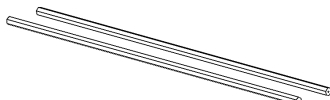
Fume Extractor Holder Reinforcement Plate 2



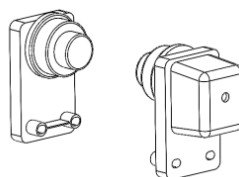
Fume Extractor Holder Reinforcement Plate 1

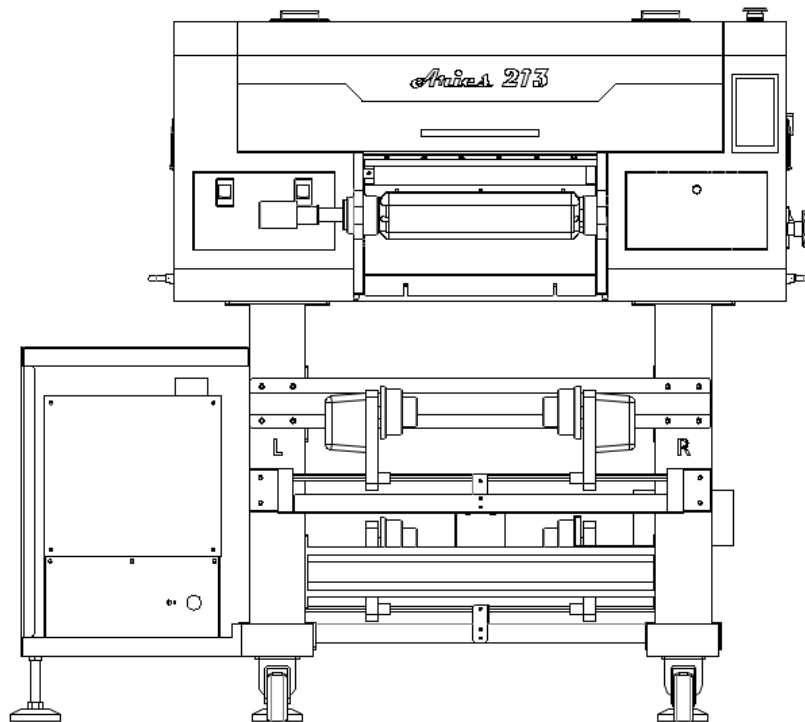
### 3. Assembly and Ink Filling

#### WARNING

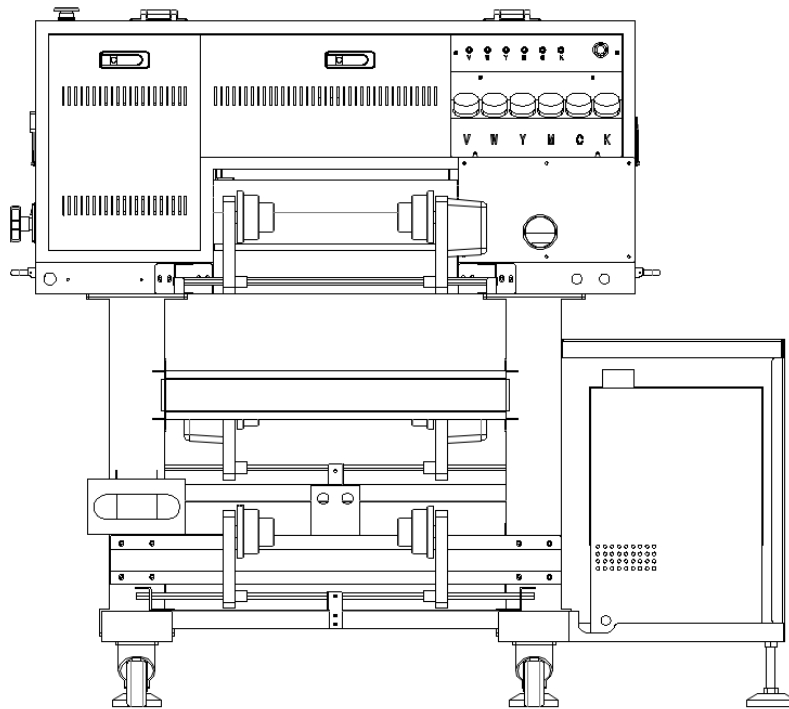
Unloading and installation must be performed by 2 to 4 or more people.

These tasks require coordinated effort by all personnel. If the machine or components are dropped, serious personal injury may result.

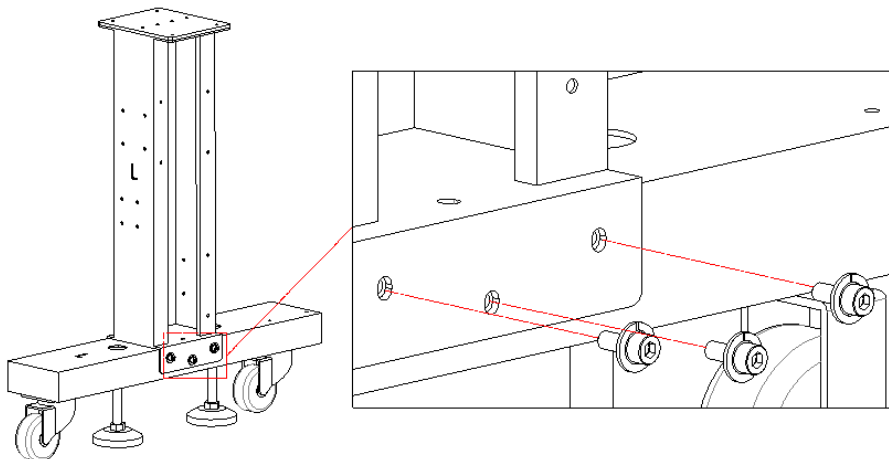


## Step 1: Stand Assembly

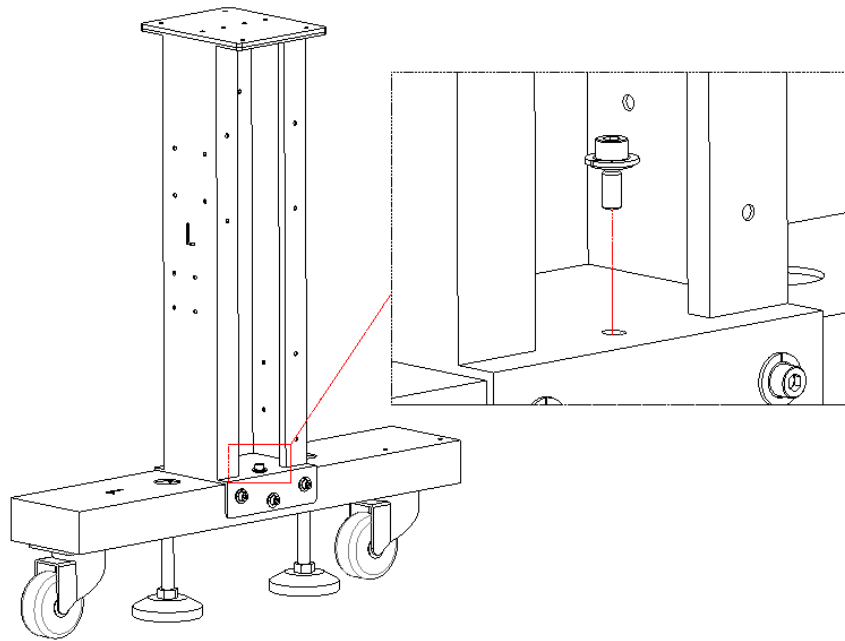
### Procedure

#### 1. INSTALLING THE SUPPORT LEGS

- Secure the support leg fixing plates to the left and right sides of the support leg using M6×16 hex socket screws. Do not fully tighten the screws at this stage.



- Secure the support leg to the base with M6×16 hex socket screws, then tighten all screws fully.

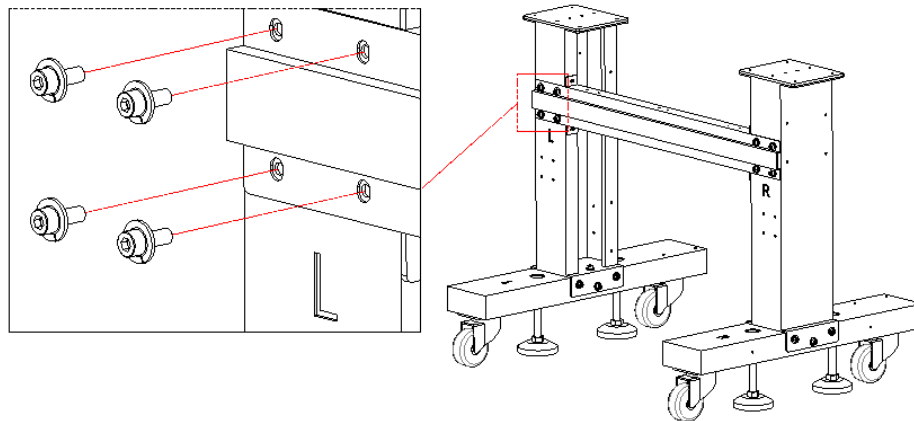


## 2. INSTALLING THE RIGHT SUPPORT LEG

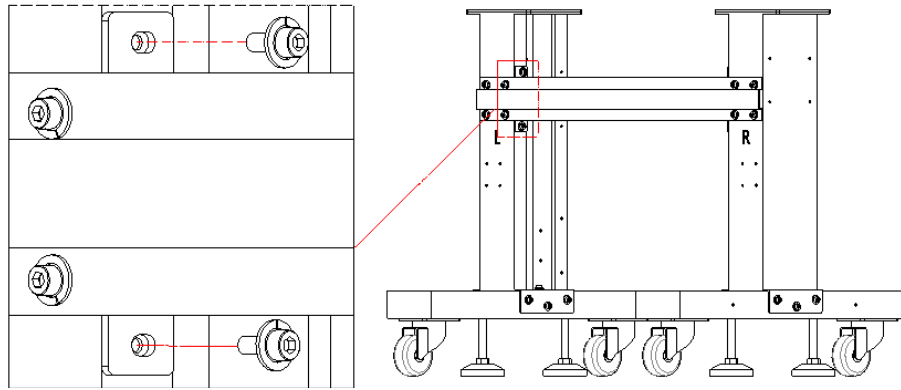
Repeat Step 1 to install the right support leg.

## 3. INSTALLING THE SUPPORT LEG REINFORCEMENT PLATE

- Secure the reinforcement plate using M6×16 hex socket screws. Do not fully tighten the screws yet.



- Secure the side of the reinforcement plate with M6×16 hex socket screws, then tighten all screws fully.



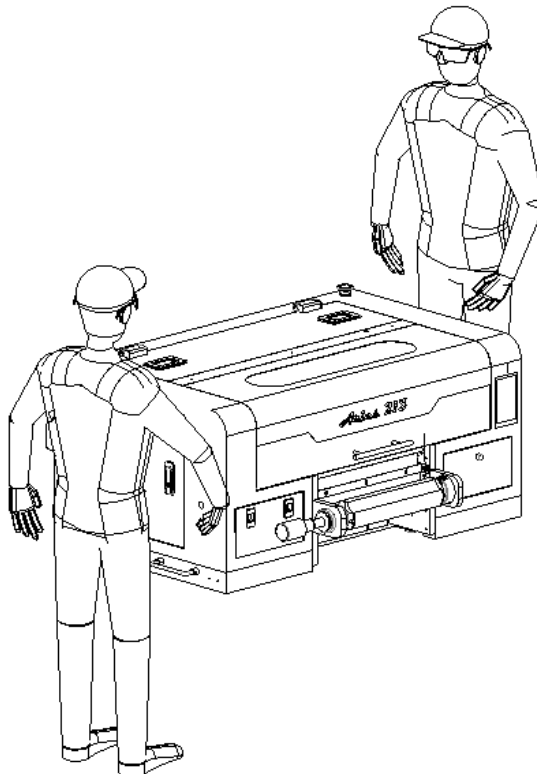
- Make sure the side of the reinforcement plate is **parallel to the support leg**.
- Ensure the reinforcement plate is **fully flush with the support leg with no gaps**.
- Any gap may affect the installation of the printer body afterward.

#### 4. INSTALLING THE REAR SUPPORT LEG REINFORCEMENT PLATE

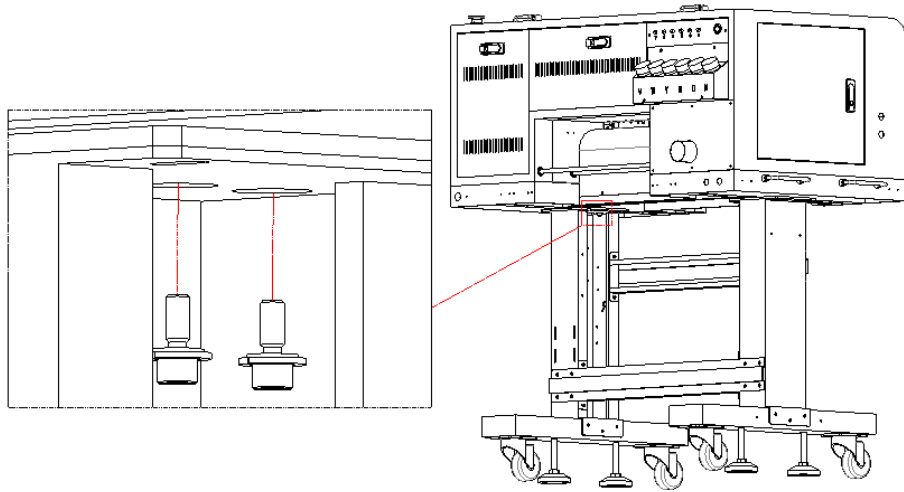
Repeat Step 3 to install the rear reinforcement plate.

#### 5. INSTALLING THE PRINTER BODY

- Lift the printer body onto the stand. This operation requires 2 to 4 or more people.

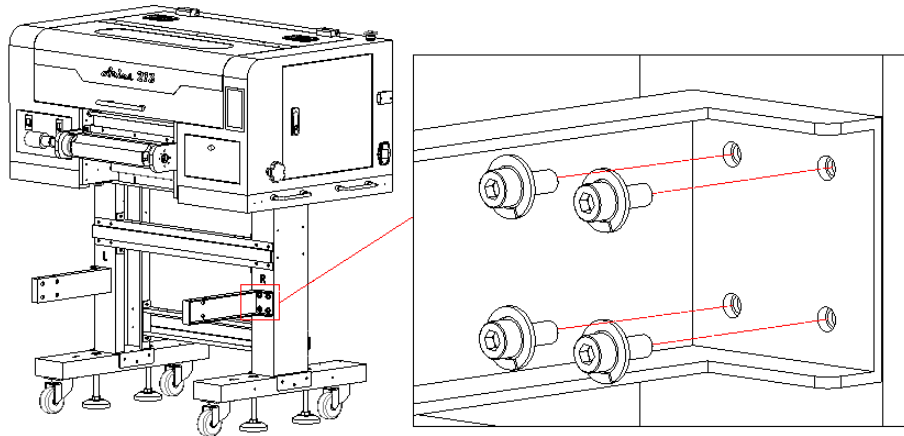


- Secure the printer body using M6×16 hex socket screws.

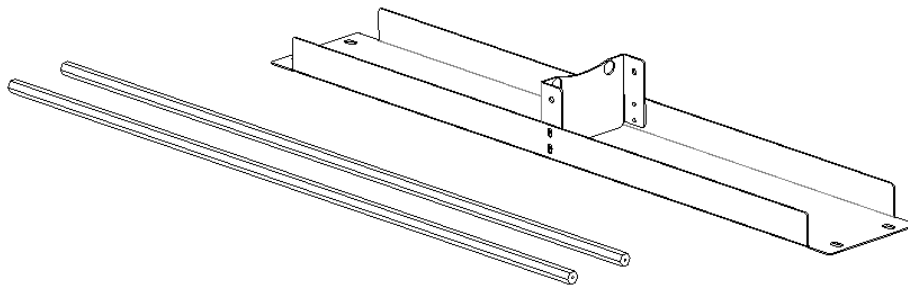


## 6. INSTALLING THE FRONT TAKE-UP REEL

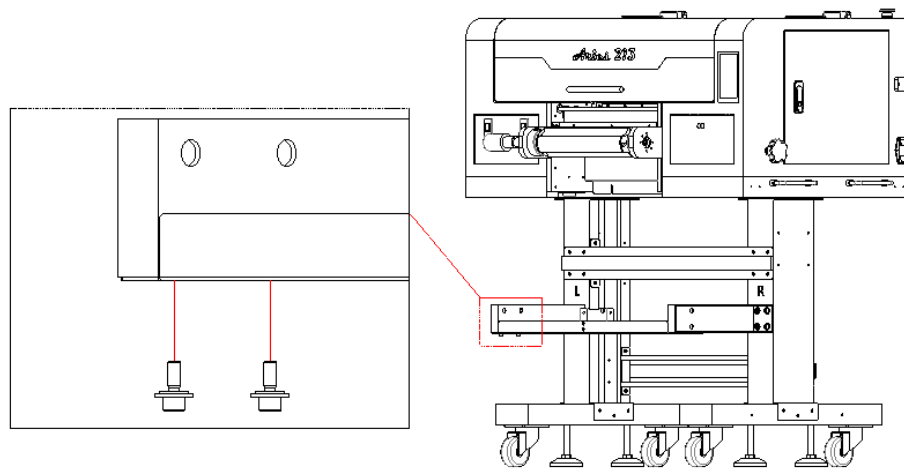
- Install the take-up reel bracket onto the support leg using M6×16 hex socket screws.



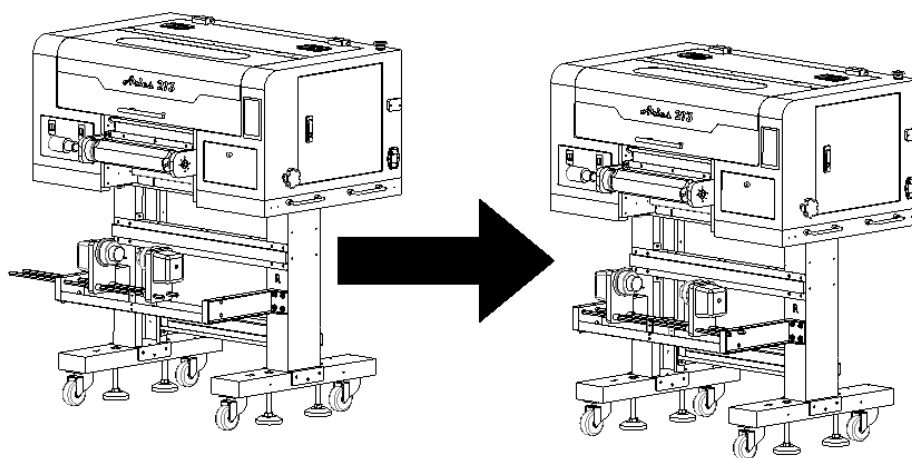
- Loosen the screws and separate the take-up reel bracket reinforcement plate from the take-up reel bar.



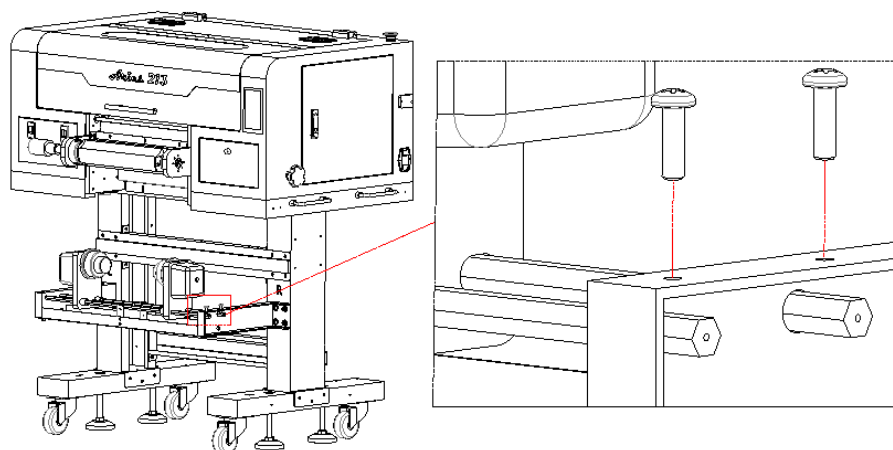
- Install the take-up reel bracket reinforcement plate onto the take-up reel bracket using M6×16 hex socket screws.



- Install the media holder and media holder bar.

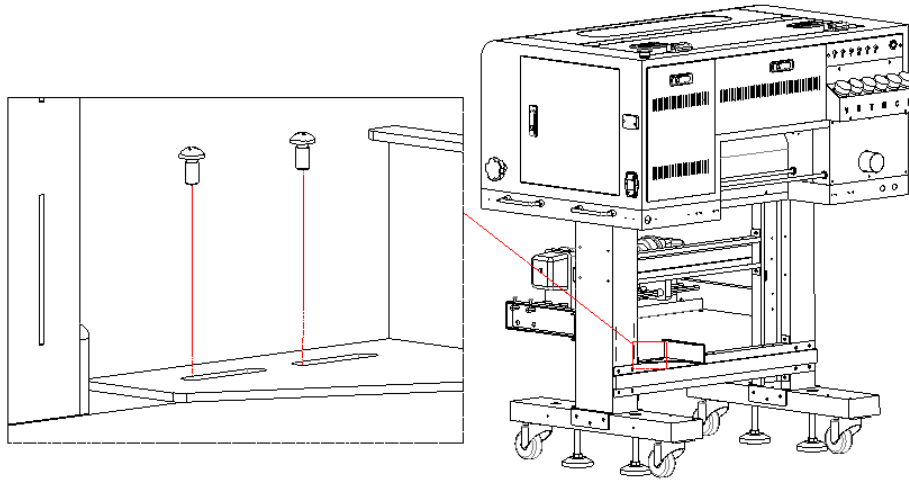


- Secure the take-up reel bar using M6×20 hex socket screws.



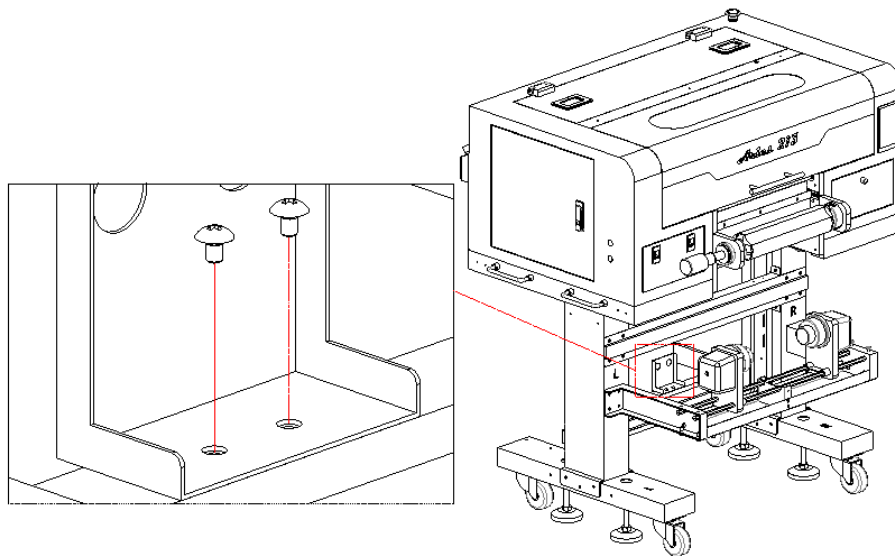
## 7. INSTALLING THE CENTER POSITIONING PLATE

Secure the center positioning plate to the support leg reinforcement plate using M3×10 round-head screws.



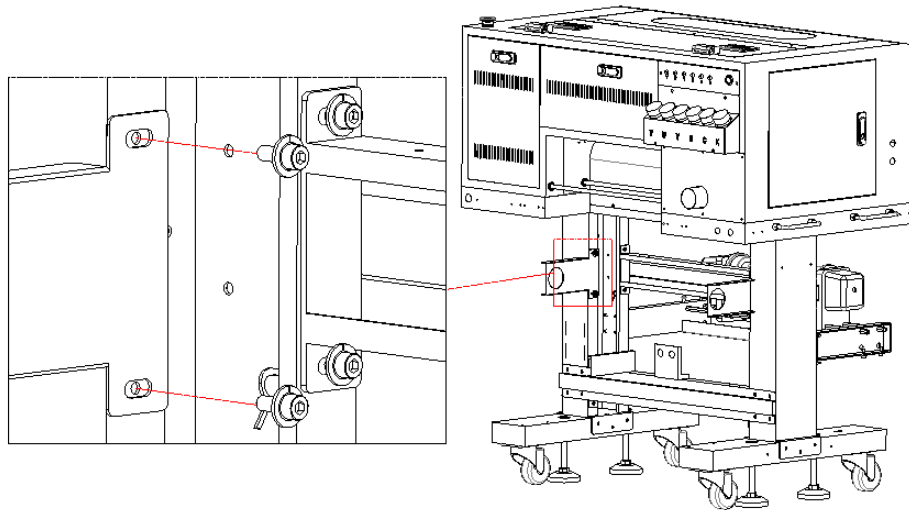
## 8. INSTALLING THE MEDIA SENSOR BRACKET

Secure the media sensor bracket to the support leg reinforcement plate using M4×6 large flat-head screws.

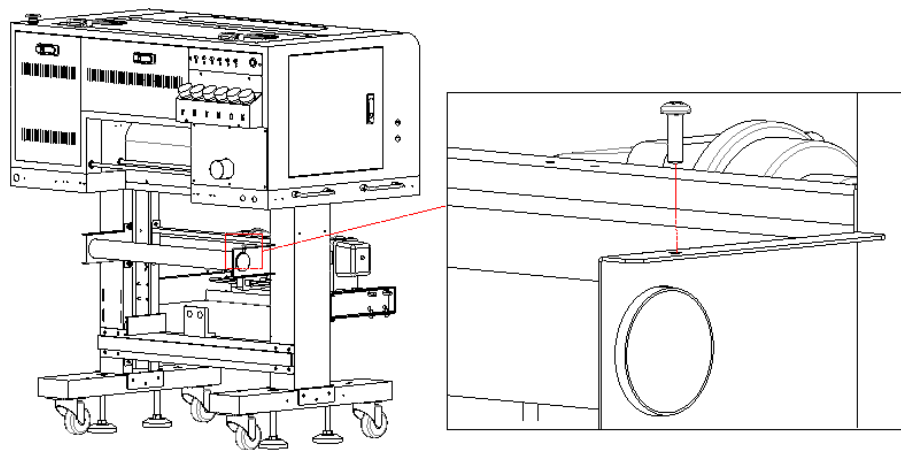


## 9. INSTALLING THE FILM TENSION BAR

- Install the film tension bar fixing plate onto the support leg using M6×16 hex socket screws.

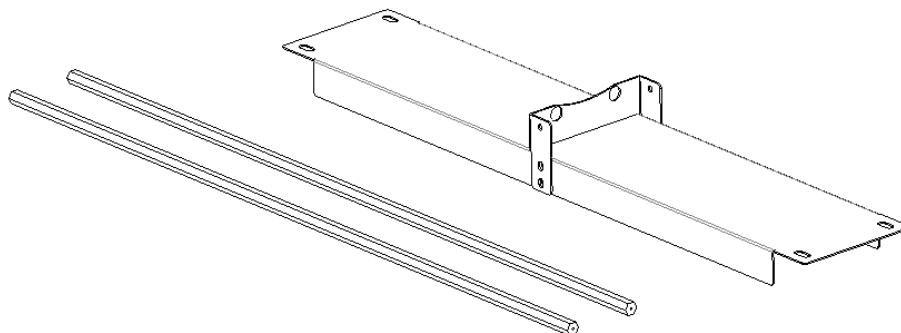


- Install the film tension bar and secure it using M6×20 hex socket screws.

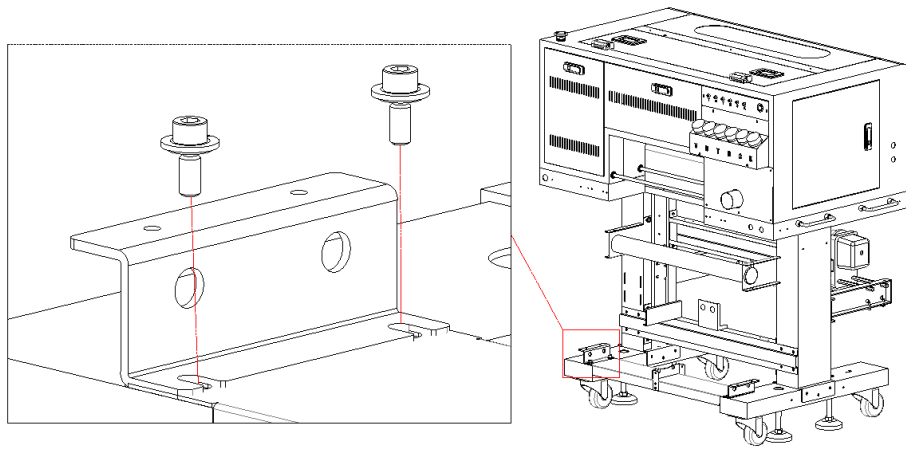


## 10. INSTALLING THE REAR MEDIA HOLDER

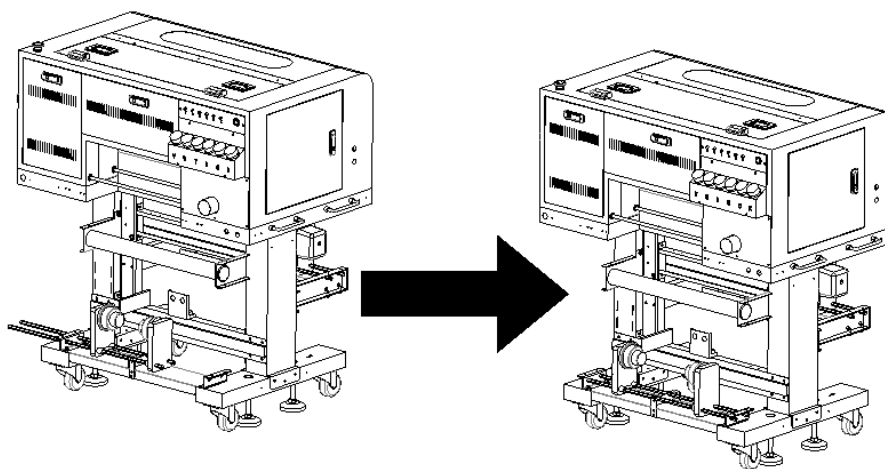
- Loosen the screws and separate the media holder bracket reinforcement plate from the media holder bar.



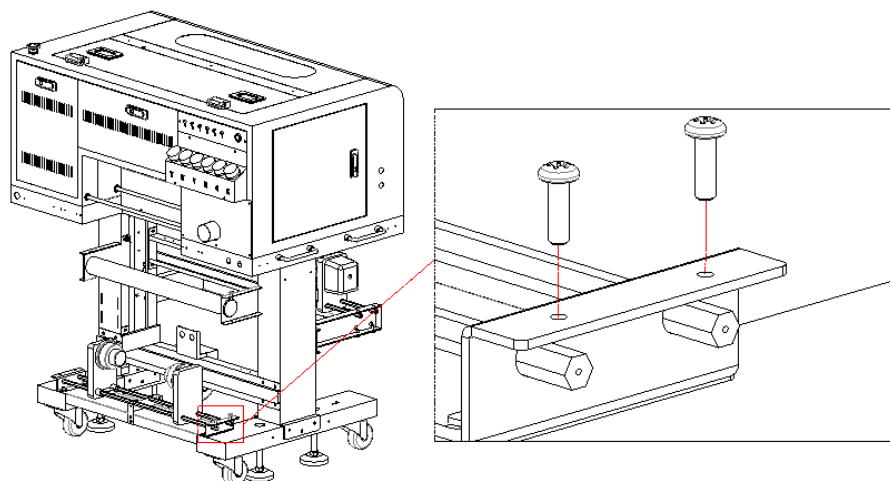
- Place the media holder bracket reinforcement plate and media holder fixing plate on the support leg base, and secure using M6×16 hex socket screws.



- Install the media holder and media holder bar.

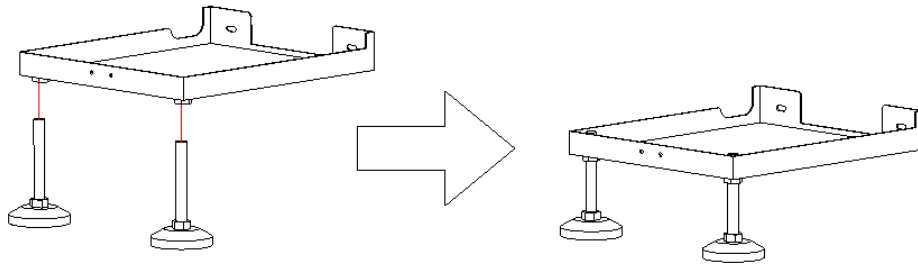


- Secure the media holder bar using M6×20 hex socket screws.

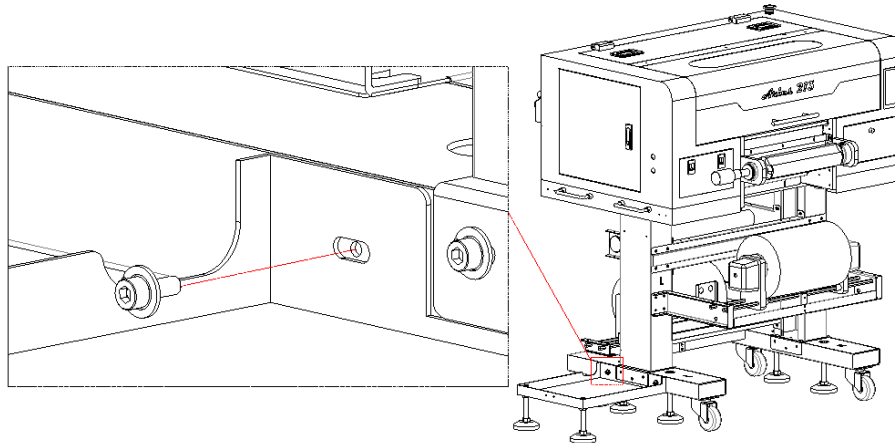


## 11. INSTALLING THE FUME EXTRACTOR HOLDER

- Install the leveling feet onto the Fume Extractor Holder.

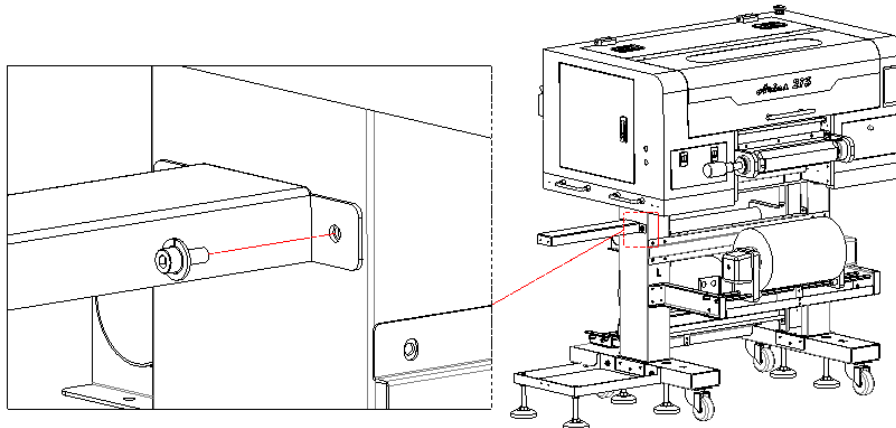


- Secure the Fume Extractor Holder to the support leg base using M6×16 hex socket screws.

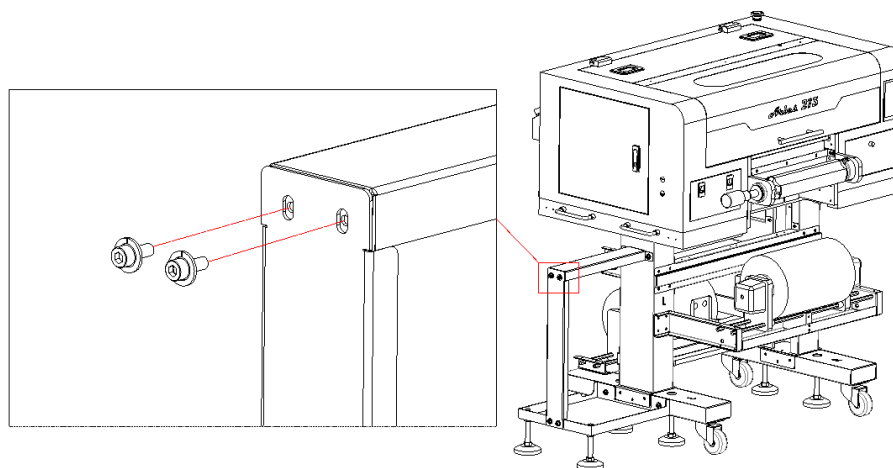


## 12. INSTALLING THE FUME EXTRACTOR HOLDER REINFORCEMENT PLATES

- Install Fume Extractor Holder Reinforcement Plate 1 onto the support leg using M6×16 hex socket screws.

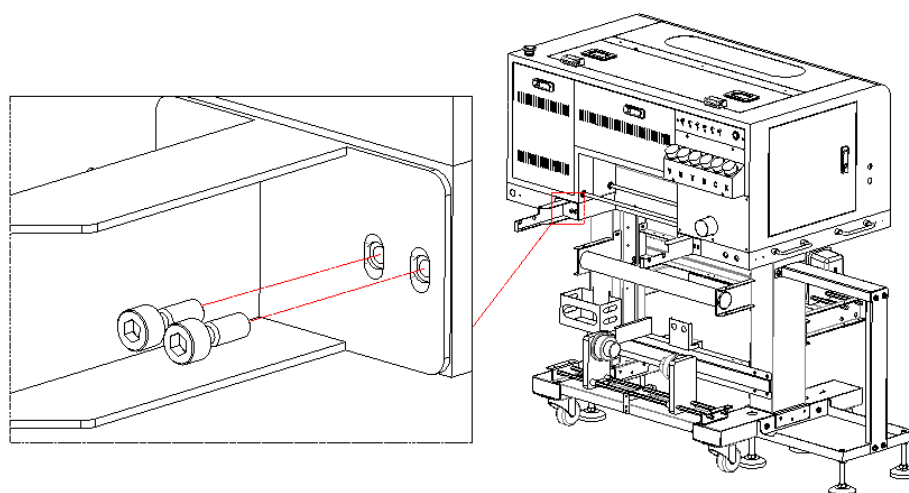


- Install Fume Extractor Holder Reinforcement Plate 2 onto Fume Extractor Holder Reinforcement Plate 1 and the Fume Extractor Holder using M6×16 hex socket screws.

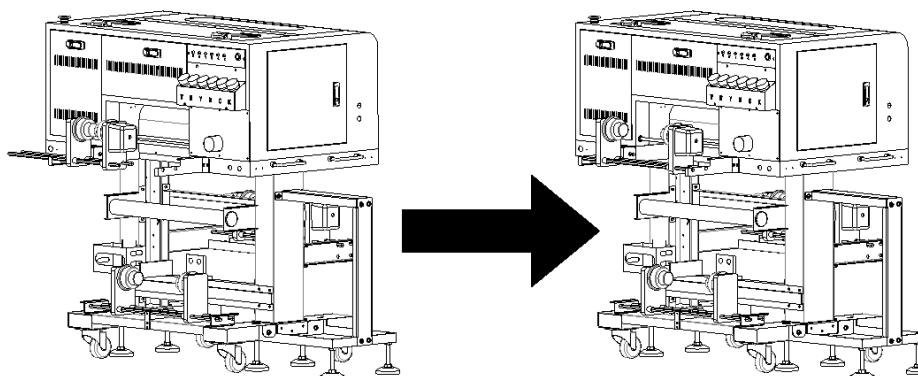


### 13. INSTALLING THE FILM TAKE-UP ASSEMBLY (FOR THE WASTE PROTECTIVE FILM FROM THE GLUED SIDE)

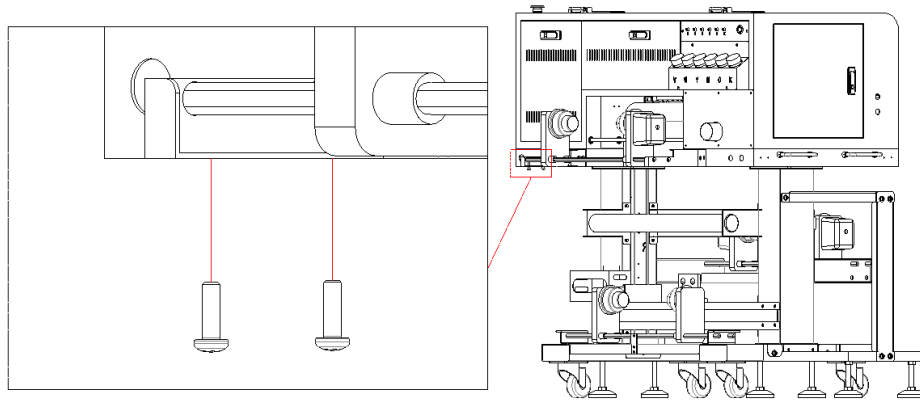
- Install the take-up reel bracket using M6×16 hex socket screws.



- Install the take-up reel support bar and media holder.



- Secure the take-up reel support bar using M6×20 hex socket screws.



## Step 2: Removing Transport Locks

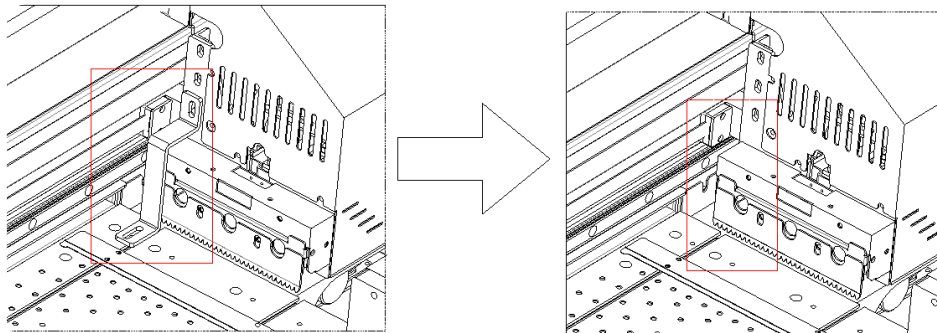
### IMPORTANT

Remove all transport locks before powering on the machine.

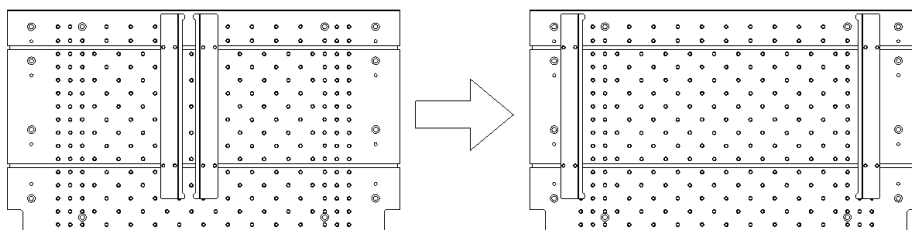
Failure to remove transport locks may result in malfunction or equipment damage during startup.

Retain all transport locks for future use. They must be installed if the machine is relocated or transported.

Procedure:



- Open the front cover and remove the carriage lock.
- Remove the media guide protective stickers and move the media guide to both sides of the platen.



## Step 3: Connecting the Power Cable and Network Cable

### WARNING

Ensure all power switches are turned off before performing this task.

Sudden movement of the machine may result in personal injury.

### WARNING

Connect the machine only to a power source that meets the specified voltage, frequency, and current requirements.

Use of an incorrect power supply or inadequate current capacity may result in fire or electric shock.

### WARNING

Handle the power cord, plug, and power outlet with care and in accordance with applicable safety requirements.

Do not use damaged power cords, plugs, or electrical outlets.

### WARNING

If an extension cord or power strip is required, ensure that it is rated to meet the machine's specified requirements.

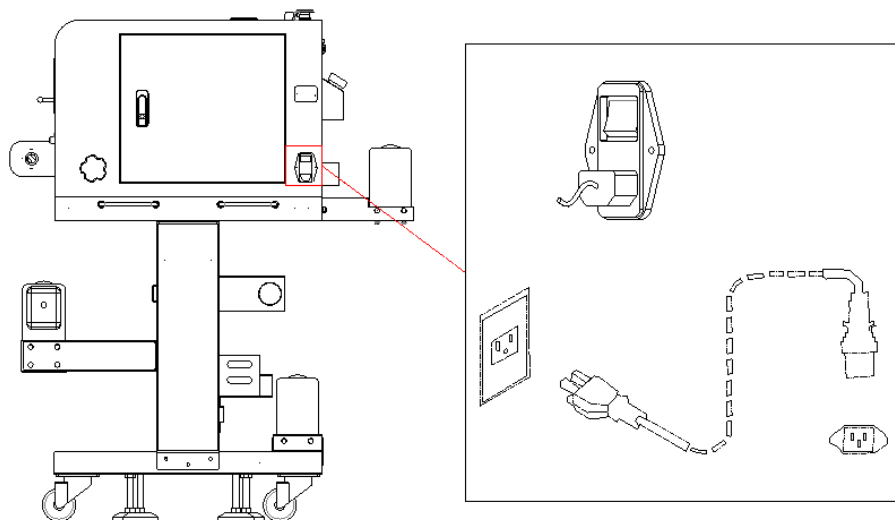
Do not connect the machine directly to a power distribution panel or permanently wired electrical equipment.

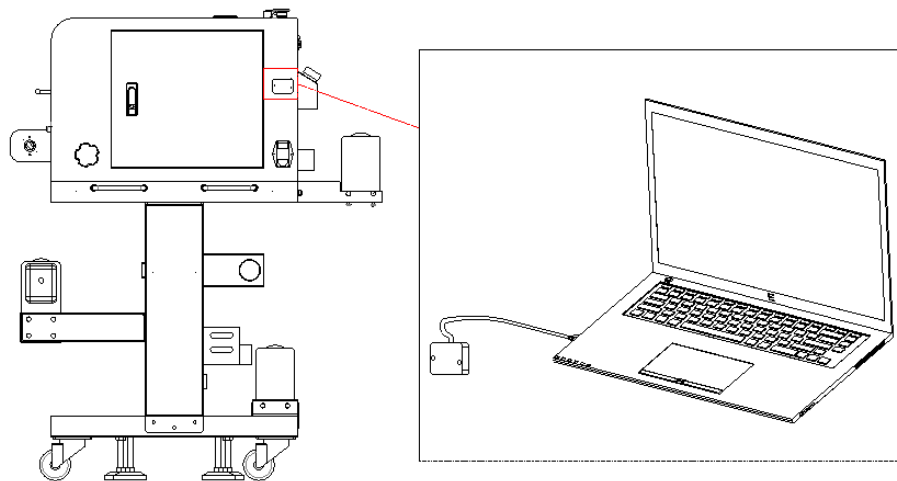
Ensure that the machine is connected to a proper protective earth (ground) connection.

Procedure:

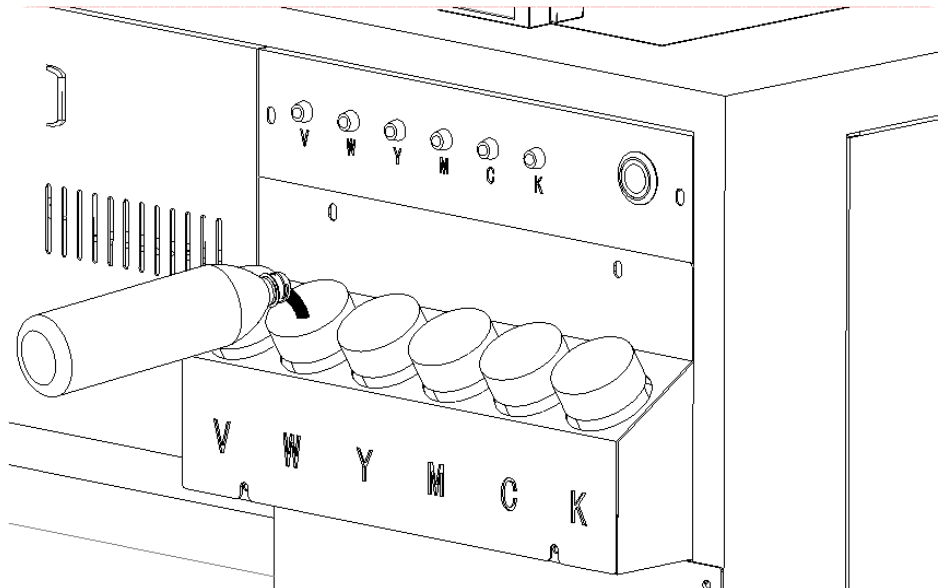


- Connect the power cable securely to the machine first, then connect the other end to a properly grounded wall outlet.
- Connect the Ethernet cable to the computer used for operation.



## Step 4: Adding Ink

- Match each ink bottle with the corresponding color label.

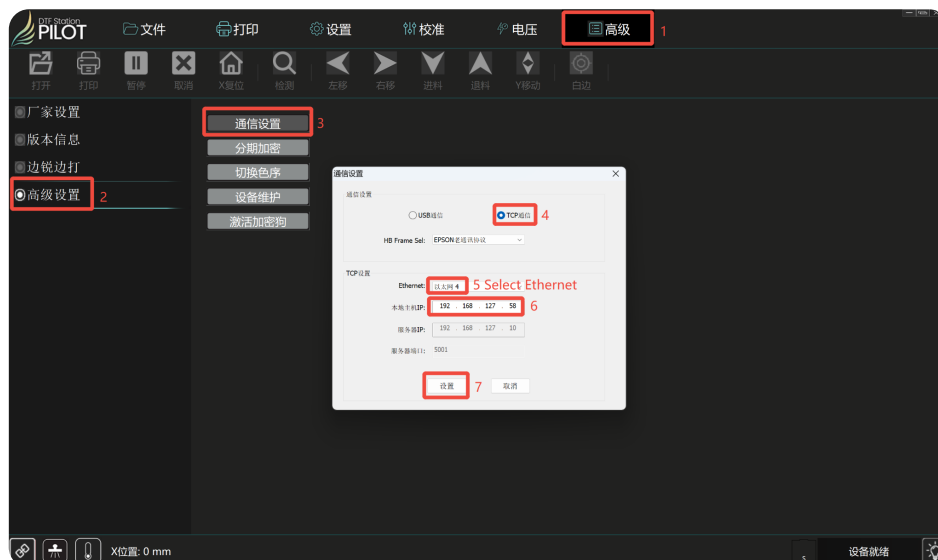


- Shake the ink bottle thoroughly before filling.
- Add the ink to the corresponding ink bottle according to the color label.

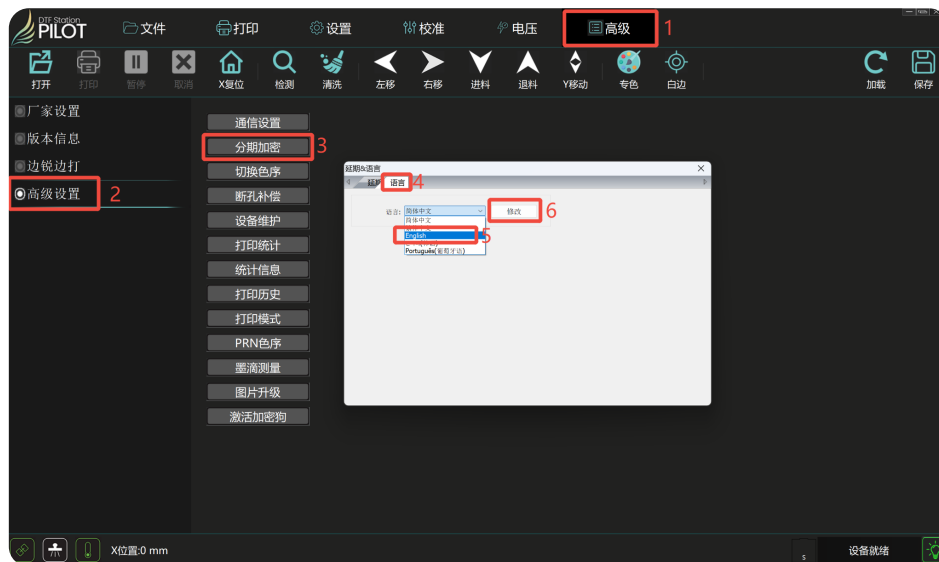
